- Offer BITS (Blues in the Schools Program) educational opportunities in public and private schools where music education has become increasingly diminished.
- Provide support funding to an area blues band and solo/duo performer to travel to Memphis TN to participate in the prestigious International Blues Challenge (IBC) presented by the National Blues Foundation.
